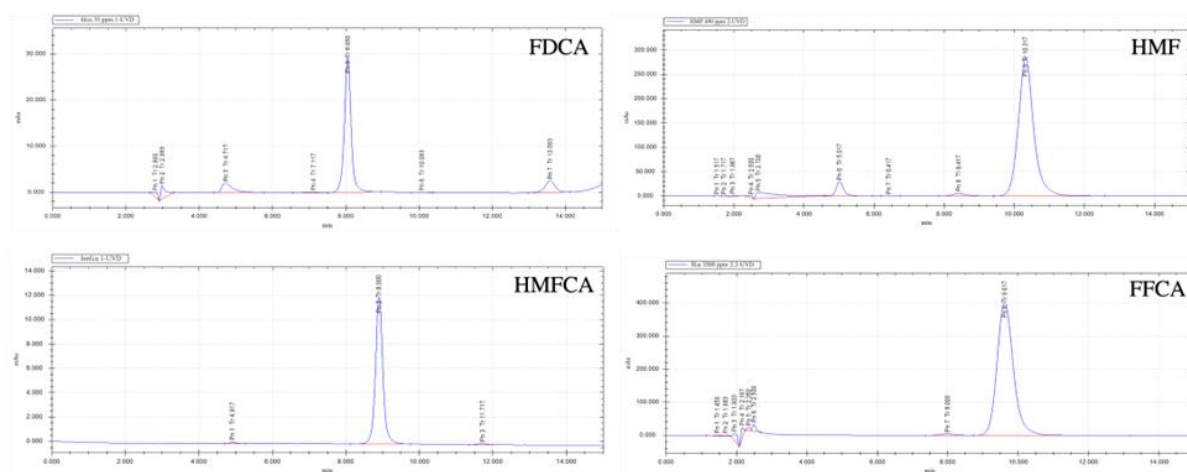


Figure S1. Standard solution analysis result with HPLC.

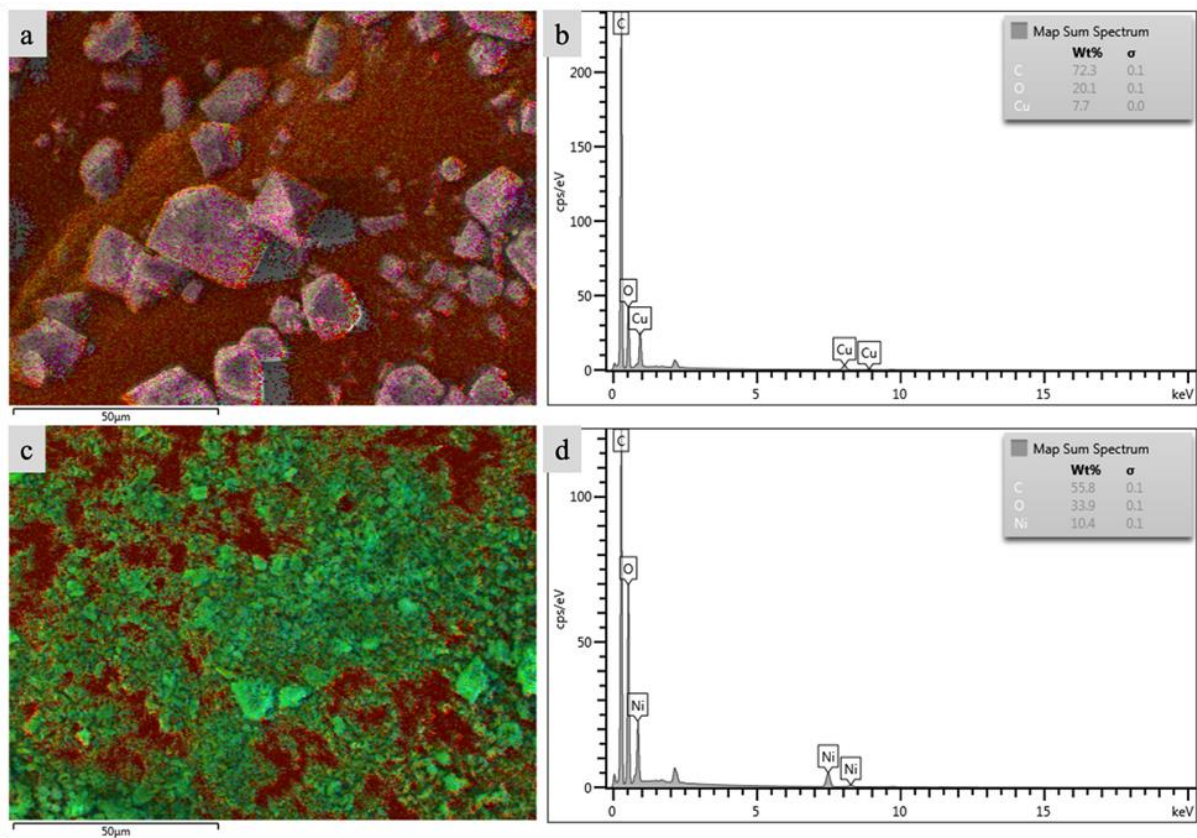
